

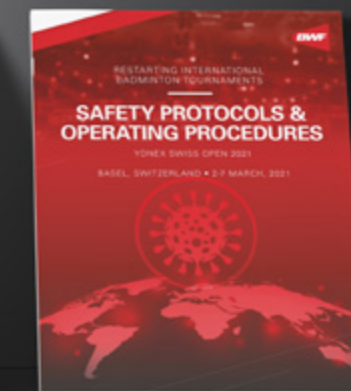

- ◀ Steps for handling positive cases including contact tracing measures can differ greatly for each tournament.





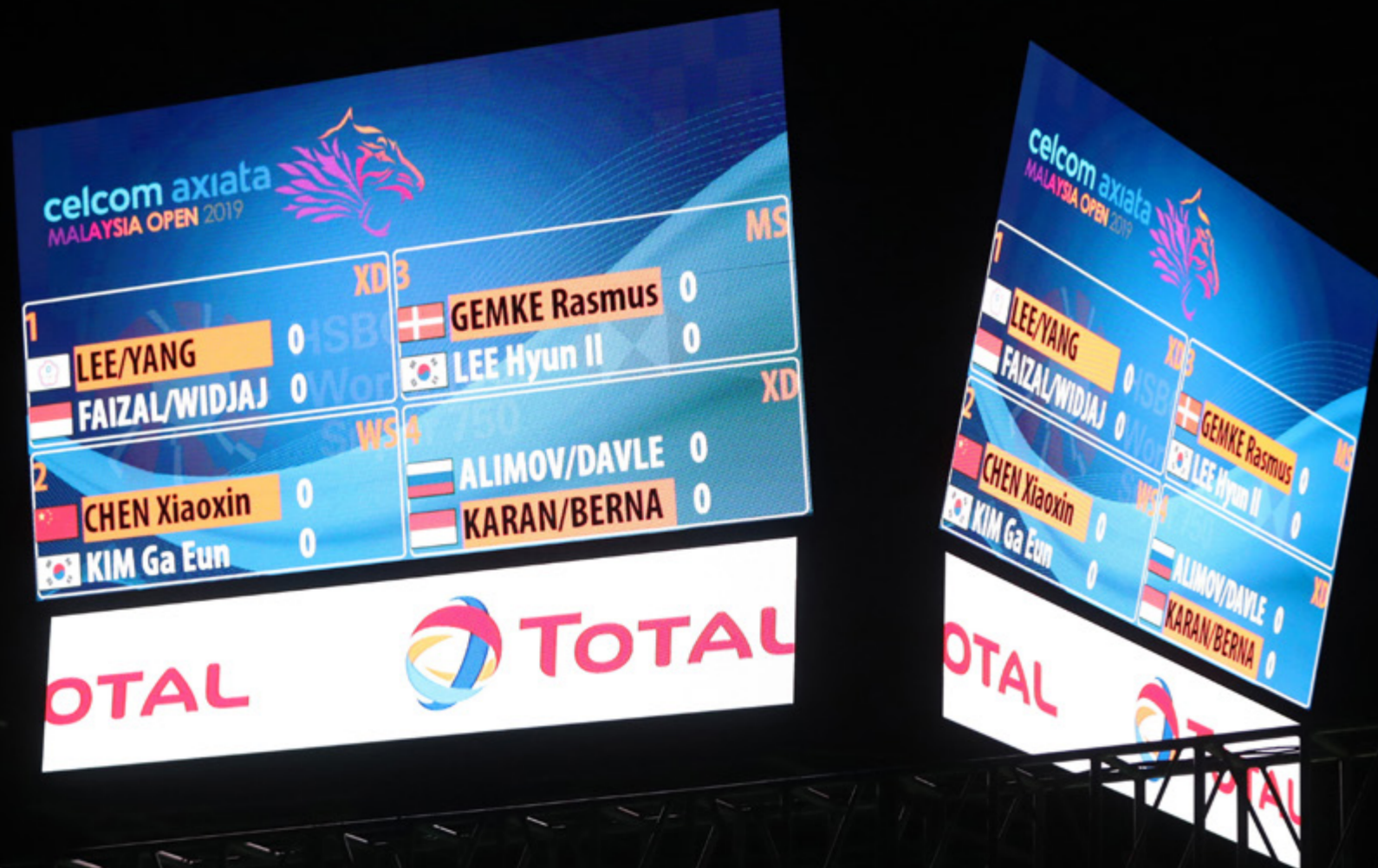
BWF TOURNAMENT CALENDAR

Here is a reminder of the changes:

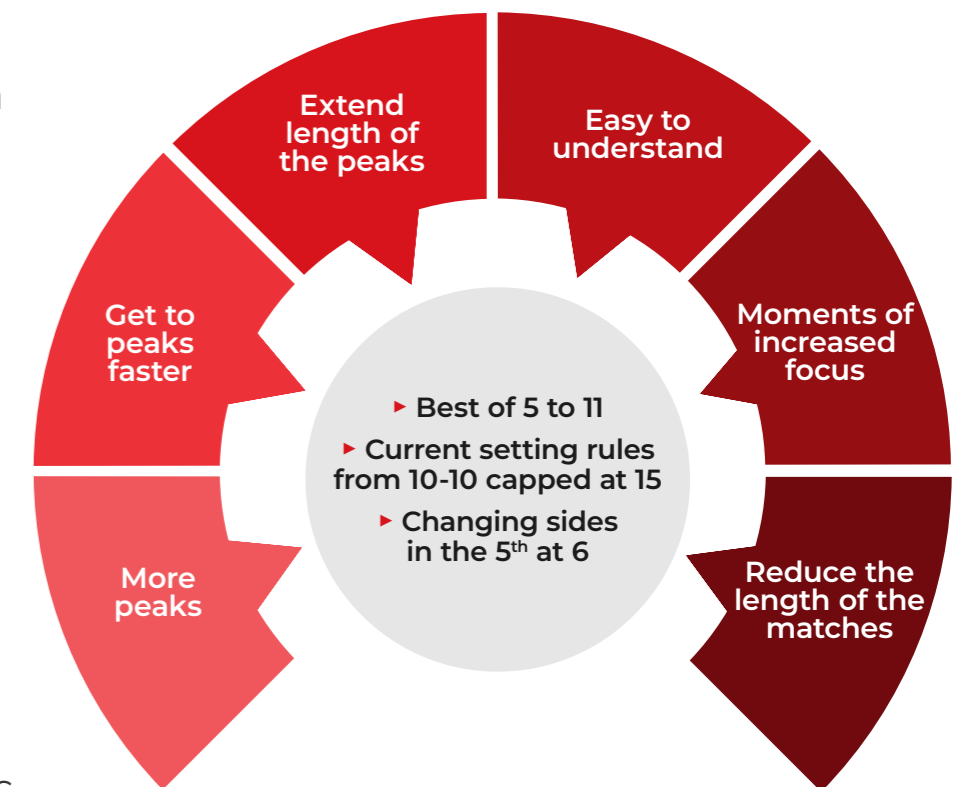
